DIRECTIONS

NOTE: If you are driving a bus, please go up Oak Street to 45th Street to get to the Museum Plaza entrance.

From the Northwest or KCI Airport

Interstate 29 South
Connect with Interstate 35 South —
Follow directions below

From the Northeast

Interstate 35 South to Hwy 71 South,
Exit — at Emanuel Cleaver II Blvd
(AKA – 47th Street)
Turn right on Emanuel Cleaver II Blvd
Turn right on Oak Street
(Next street after Rockhill Road)
Parking Garage entrance is on Oak Street
just north of building

From the West

Interstate 70 East
Exit — Interstate 670 East
Exit — interstate 35 South
Left lane Exit — Southwest Traffic way
Traveling south from approximately 31st Street
to 47th Street
Look for brown directional signs
Left on Emanuel Cleaver II Blvd (AKA – 47th Street)
Left on Oak Street (Next light after Main Street)
Parking Garage Entrance is on Oak Street
just north of building

From the East

Interstate 70 West
Exit — 35 South (See directions From the West)

From the Southwest

Interstate 35 North
Exit — Shawnee Mission Pkwy/Hwy 50 (Hwy 56 in
KS)
taking a right heading East
Continue on same road which will become Ward
Pkwy
heading east and it will become Volker Blvd.
Left on Oak Street (Next light after Main Street)
Parking Garage Entrance is on Oak Street
just North of building

From the Southeast

From Interstate 435 going either direction
Exit — Hwy 71 North (Bruce R. Watkins Dr.)
Exit — Swope Pkwy
Left (West) on Swope Pkwy
(which will become Volker Blvd)
Right on Oak Street (next light after Rockhill Rd)
Parking Garage Entrance is on Oak Street
just North of building

Changes

- Notify studio workshops or school tours no later than three business days prior to your visit with changes regarding the number of students in your group.
- Studio Workshops: Attendance changes must be received at least three business days prior to your visit in order to receive a fee adjustment.
- Additional students for School Tour and Studio Workshop groups will only be accommodated if space and staff allow.
- Arrive promptly. School Tours and Studio Workshops will not be extended due to late arrivals.

CANCELLATIONS

School Tour and Studio Workshop cancellations must be received by email five or more business days before your visit.

Inclement Weather

In the event of inclement weather, the Museum will close if the University of Missouri Kansas City (UMKC) closes. If your school is closed due to inclement weather, please notify the Museum as soon as possible.

Chaperones:

One adult chaperone for every 10 students is required.

Divide Your Group

School Tours: Do not divide students into groups before arriving at the Museum.

Studio Workshops: Please divide students into groups of not more than 15 students each. This effort will facilitate the process of assigning students to classrooms once they arrive at the Museum.

Lunch

Lunch in the Kansas City Sculpture Park

Schools may bring sack lunches and picnic on the grounds of the Kansas City Sculpture Park; *there are no facilities for students to eat sack lunches inside the Museum. Teachers are responsible for making alternate arrangements in inclement weather.*

- Photography is welcome in the permanent collection galleries, but please do not use a flash.
- Use cell phones only in Kirkwood Hall, Bloch Lobby and food service areas.
- Be considerate of others.
- Arrive on time.

Special Needs/ Accessibility

The Museum's galleries are accessible to students with disabilities. Please notify the Museum as soon as possible if you have any students with special needs. Giving advance notice will make the visit more enjoyable for all.

The Museum's collection includes original objects from all over the world. The various cultures represented express themselves in many ways. While we do not focus on works of art depicting nudity, students will pass by objects of this nature during their Museum visit.
