

Outdoor Photography Guidelines

- **All professional photographers, including bridal and portrait photographers, must check in at the Security Command Center before beginning their photography session.** The Security Command Center is located at the Museum's business entrance at the northwest corner of the Nelson-Atkins Building, off Oak Street. **Photographers will be asked to sign an agreement,** indicating they have read and accept Museum photography guidelines.
- Photographs taken are for personal use only. Images may not be reproduced for commercial purposes (although we realize that professional bridal/portrait photographers will be selling photographs to their clients).
- **To help us preserve the outdoor sculptures, please do not climb, lean or sit on them.** You also may not place props or equipment on the sculptures or enter the reflecting pool.
- **All equipment should remain at least six feet from the works of art.**
- The Museum building, including its public restrooms, may NOT be used for changing clothes, make-up, etc. For portrait and bridal pictures, all parties must be dressed and ready to be photographed before arriving at the Museum.
- Please be courteous to other visitors and do not obstruct access to the Museum or the Kansas City Sculpture Park.
- During Museum public hours, photographers and their subjects may park in the garage (\$5 parking fee). Oak Street is available for parking when the garage is closed.
- Currently, there is no fee for outdoor photography.
- Professional portrait and bridal photography is not permitted inside the Museum.

****Security personnel have the authority to enforce these rules and failure to comply may result in removal from the premises. Please follow the officer's instructions.***
